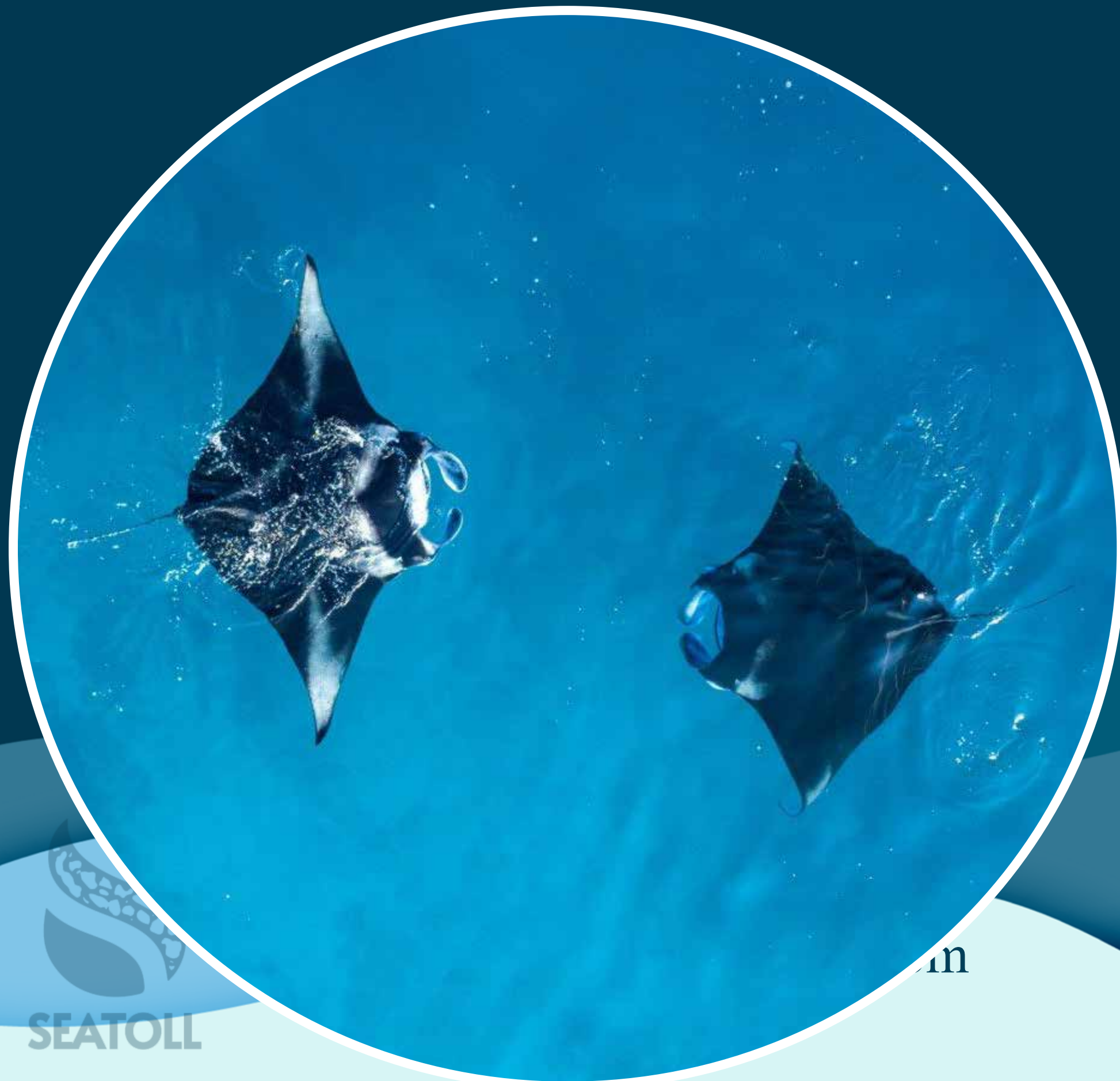

The Maldives is home to 26 atolls and upwards of 1000 individual islands. Kamadhoo is lucky to be at the very heart of the baa atoll, a UNESCO Biosphere reserve at the very heart of northern Maldives. Whilst the Baa atoll is fortunate to have a scattering of resorts and private retreats there is also a handful, 13 of local islands that remain inhabited by a discreet population of 11,000. For local Maldivians, these islands remain their permanent home, maintaining the truly rich and quietly confident Maldivian culture.

Hanifay Bay is Located just 20 minutes away from KAMADHOO ISLAND by speed boat, Hanifaru Bay is the absolute epitome of why the Baa atoll's biodiversity is a world renowned ecological site. A perfectly proportioned flank to the east of the Baa region, Hanifaru bay is home to some of the largest gatherings of manta rays in the world as well as whale sharks. Gorging on the plankton that naturally occurs in abundance during certain peaks of the year, witness these gentle-giants as they

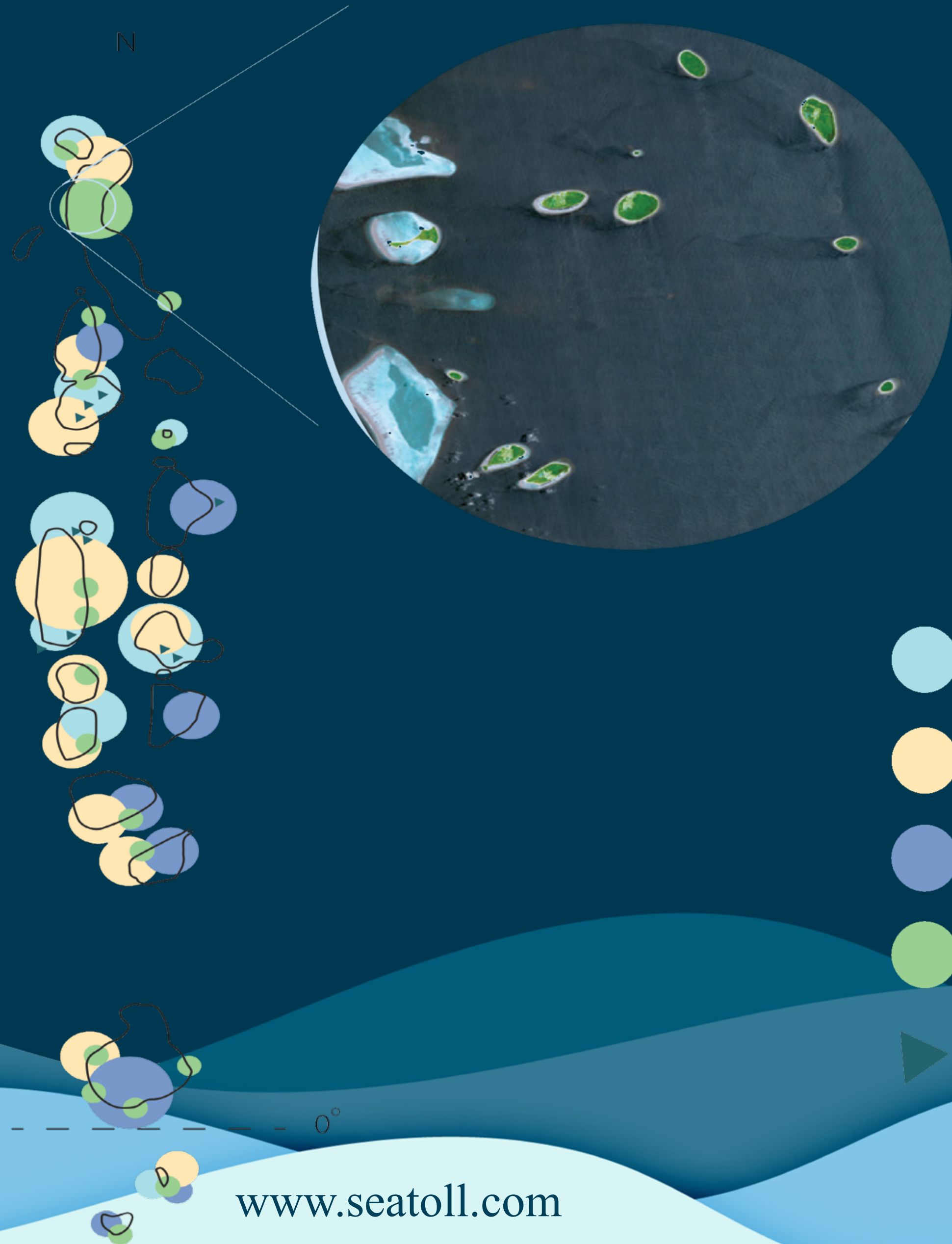

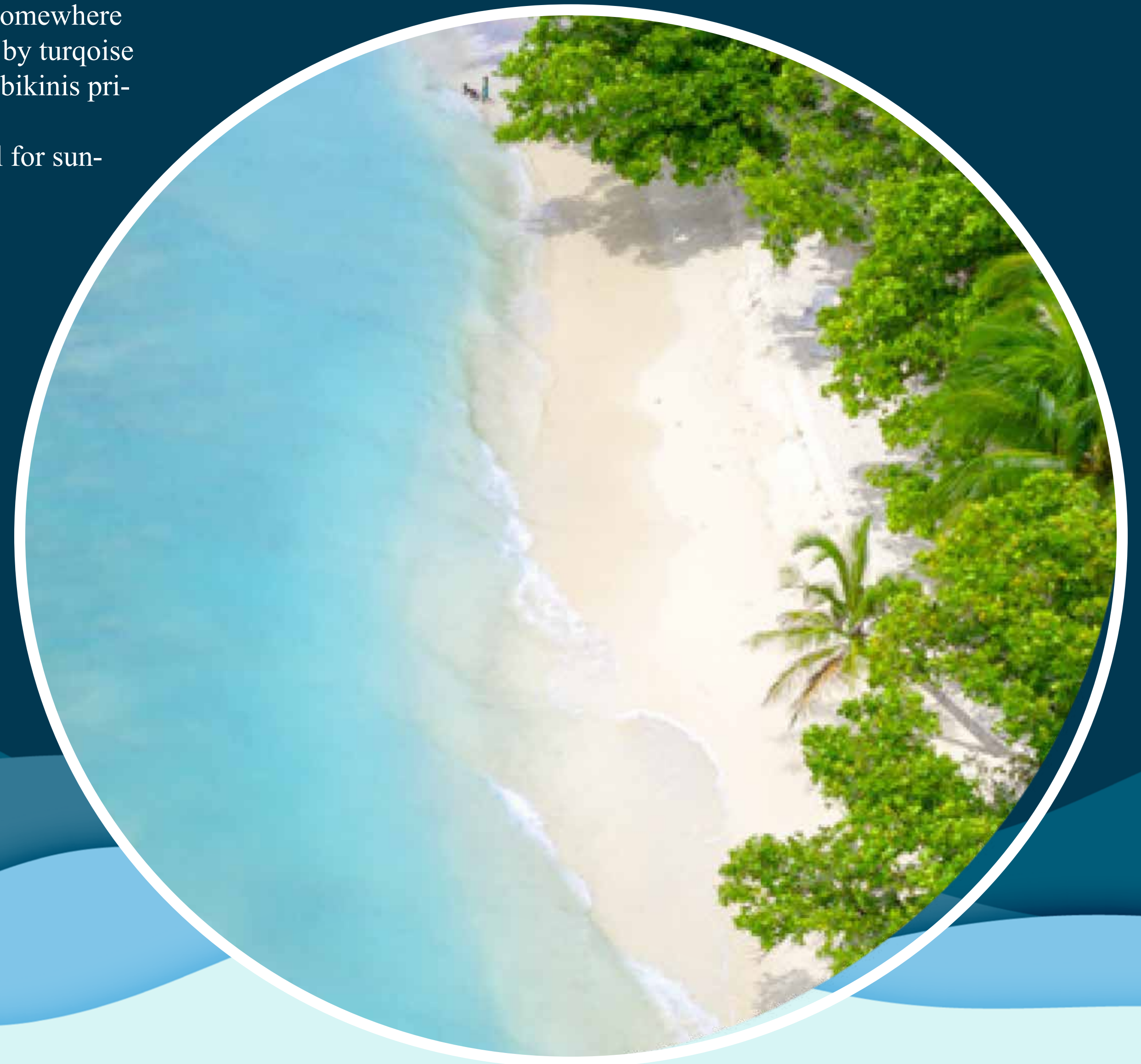

OVER A 1000 YEARS OF HISTORY



Islands have preserved most of its historic sites which have not been destroyed over the years through natural erosion, The Maldivian people existed within the islands as separate remote communities centuries before the first king who united the twelve hundred isles in early 12th century,

Local islands host historic sites such as old Buddhist temple ruins, centuries-old coral-stone mosques, residences of national heroes and more historic events and stories preserved word-of-mouth by the people,

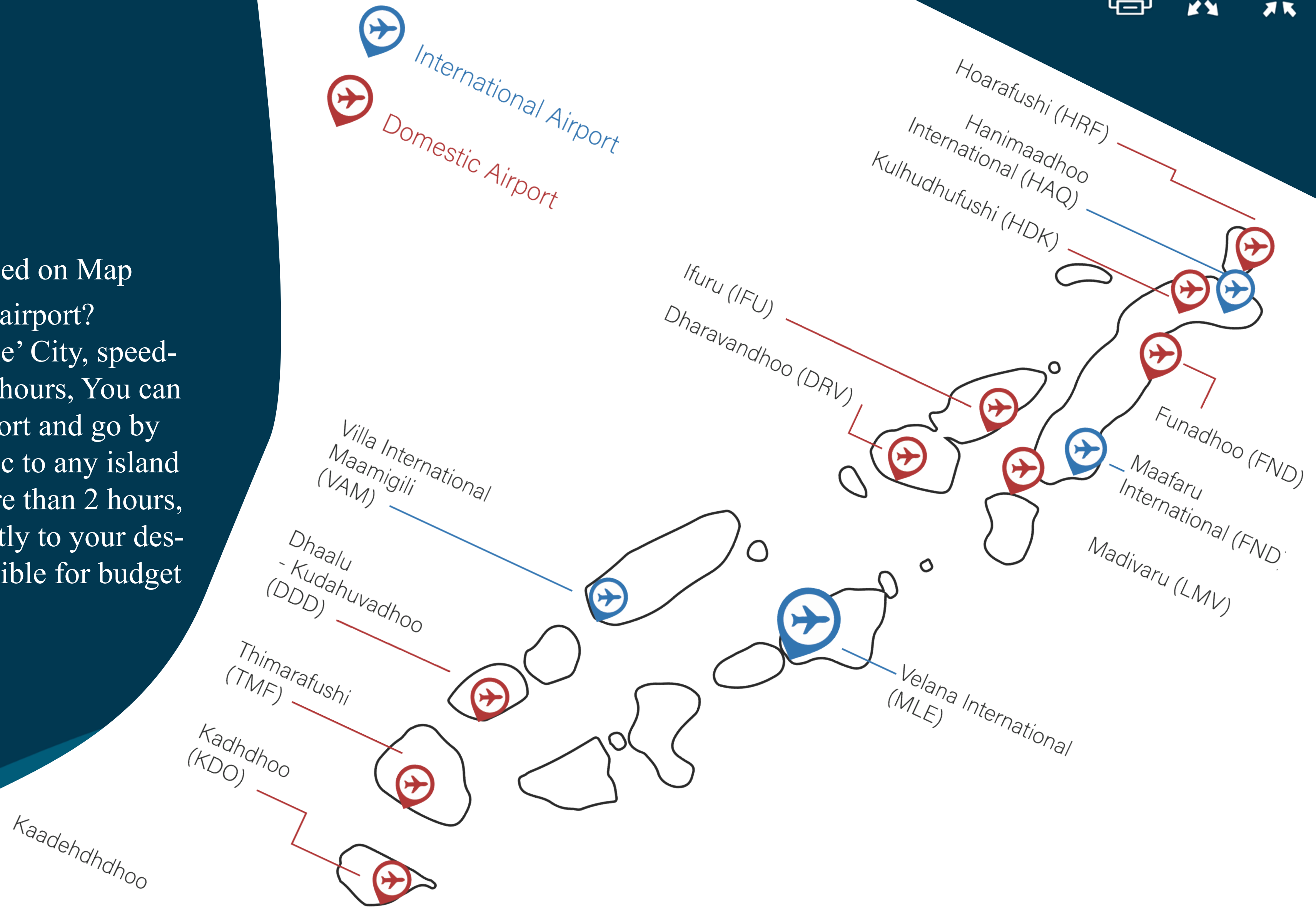
Speedboat - All Regions
